APRSO - Governance

• APRSO has been established by the development partners and was announced in Stockholm in February 2020.

• Different possible Long-term Governance options of the APRSO are under consideration.

• Current/interim operations are through an ADB regional TA which will cover the APRSO for the first years of operation while the organization grows.



APRSO – Governance (continued)

• The governance structure of APRSO could have a General Assembly comprising of the member countries.

• The General Assembly would be supported by a Steering Committee and delivered by different task forces.

• All these bodies would be led by and comprised of members from the countries in the region.



APRSO – memberships

• Invites for countries to become members of APRSO were sent by ADB on behalf of the development partners from December 2019.

• Membership entails the countries to address road safety issues, strive to improve collection and analysis of road safety data and other benefits.
